In order to do your applications, we require the following plus the proof of payment to fulfil the service.

- We collect and deliver the final certificates once it is ready at Home Affairs via courier.
 - The unabridged documents normally takes 8-12 weeks, Vault documents takes much longer to which I cannot give a timeline. Currently, we are working on approximately 6 weeks.
 - There are times where the records are lost and we may require additional documentation for DHA to repopulate the records.
 - For expedition, you will need to collect the document at the Home Affairs you applied at (if any) and you will collect at the place of application.
 - For Marriage Certificates we require a copy of the marriage register, we can try our best to assist by contacting the church / minister – you will need to provide details of where you were married, minister etc.
- For UMC applications without a bi30, we cannot commit to a timeline and no guarantee. Unabridged Marriage certificates are taking longer than expected and we are unable to commit to a timeline.
- All fees are payable upfront.
 - Should Ask Chris not be able to obtain the document, which may be out of our control, a refund will be due less the admin fees of the service provider.
 - Ask Chris makes use of 3rd party services and to our knowledge, all activities to assist in the services, are legal and we will not be held responsible for any illegal actions that may or may not take place
